WEST PORT UPDATE

West Port builders closed out a successful year in 2021 with 120 sales at Port Charlotte's premier new master planned community. The community's first three of five builders opened models and started sales between March and May. Sales were in the first two villages to open at West Port - Isles with Lennar and Hammocks with M/I and Maronda.

Developers Kolter Land and Four Star are finishing up three new villages that will open soon. Next up is the gated Cove village that features D.R. Horton homes. Their model opens for sales of single-family homes in late January. Ryan Homes will open their model and kickoff sales of single-family homes in the Palms village this spring. The first must-family home sales will follow in Lennar's Landings village. Commercial properties are also planned for the community on frontage along SR776 and US41 with the former now actively being marketed.

A neighborhood shopping plaza is in the design phases at the intersection of SR 776 and Centennial Boulevard. The plaza will feature service type businesses and restaurants that will serve the residents of West Port and neighboring communities.
